### **Professional career**

Before joining INTERPOL, Mr. Stock was the Vice President of the Bundeskriminalamt (Federal Criminal Police Office) in Germany.

From 1978 to 1987 Mr. Stock was a police officer in Hesse.

In 1984 Mr. Stock left to pursue a career in law and from 1996 to 1998 was the Deputy Head of Section at the Bundeskriminalamt.

In 1998 he was appointed Professor and as founding rector of the Police College for Higher Professional Training in Saxony-Anhalt.

In 2000 he became Head of the Institute of Law Enforcement Studies and Training at the Bundeskriminalamt.

In 2004 he was appointed Vice President of the Bundeskriminalamt.

In 2005 he was elected as a member of INTERPOL's Executive Committee

In 2007 he was appointed as the Vice-President for Europe on INTERPOL's Executive Committee
